

The Friends of Richmond Park Photography Competition 2010

Competition Rules

The competition is open to young people 18 years and under

There are four separate categories:

Under 7; 7-11; 12-15 and 16-18 (age on 10th. May 2010)

All entries should clearly state the age group category being entered

All entries must feature a Richmond Park scene (its wildlife, flora and fauna, or historic buildings) **WITHOUT people, cars or pets.**

All entries should be given a title

All entries should be submitted with an official entry form

Each entrant may enter a maximum of three photographs. All photographs should be the work of the entrant, unaided.

Photographs must be printed on high quality photographic paper, in colour or black and white, in size 7" x 5" Do not write on the back of the photograph

All entries must be received by **Monday 10th. May**

Send entries to Friends of Richmond Park Photography Competition, 16 Wayside, East Sheen, London SW14 7LN. Or hand in to the Visitor Centre adjacent to Pembroke Lodge, in a sealed envelope

Judging will take place during the week commencing 17th. May

Prizegiving will take place at Pembroke Lodge on Saturday 12th. June

The judges' decision is final. Any photographer who has won a prize will be ineligible to win a further prize, but could be awarded a 'highly commended'

**Prizes The winner in each category will receive £60 in photography vouchers
Runner-up £30 and 3rd. £20**

We regret we will not be able to return photographs submitted for the competition, although winners will receive an enlarged and framed copy of their winning entry.

Copyright in all photographs submitted remains with the photographers who submitted them. However, the photographers of the winning images will give the Friends non-exclusive rights to use their work in publicity to promote the Friends for a period of one year. Images so used will credit the photographer.
