

# FRP volunteers under 18 and vulnerable adults



The Friends of Richmond Park (FRP) welcomes all volunteers. However, for insurance and legal reasons<sup>1</sup>, volunteers aged less than 18 years and vulnerable adults may participate in FRP volunteering activities only where:

- the work to be undertaken does not involve equipment requiring skilled operation; and
- the individual has been trained in the tasks to be performed; and
- the individual is supervised at all times by a nominated responsible adult.

The nominated adult must be a parent or guardian and must sign this form.
